RESIDENTIAL QUALIFICATION

A resident for the purposes of residents' parking facilities is defined by Article 2 of the Kensington and Chelsea (Parking Places) Order as "a person whose usual place of abode is at premises, the postal address of which is in any street or part of a street described in a Schedule to the Order". The streets in each particular controlled zone are listed in a Schedule which is part of the Order.

A PERSON WHO DOES NOT REGULARLY LIVE AND SLEEP IN PREMISES AS A FULL-TIME RESIDENT DOES NOT QUALIFY IRRESPECTIVE OF HIS INTEREST IN THE PREMISES.

PENALTIES

The attention of applicants for the issue and renewal of parking permits is drawn to Part "D" of the application form PAR.1 and Part "D" of the renewal form PAR.1A, also to the following extracts from the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, which provides heavy penalties for making a false statement, forgery, etc.

FORGERY OF DOCUMENTS

Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967:

SECTION 86(1)

A person shall be guilty of an offence, who with intent to deceive —

- (a) forges or alters, or uses or lends to, or allows to be used by, any other person any ticket issued by a parking meter, or any authorisation by way of such a certificate, other means of identification or a resident's parking permit or season ticket, or
- (b) makes or has in his possession any document so closely resembling any such ticket or authorisation as to be calculated to deceive.

SECTION 86(2)

A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) above shall be liable —

- (a) on conviction or indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years;
- (b) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding £1,000.

FALSE STATEMENTS

Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967:

SECTION 86(3) as amended by Section 21, R.T. Act, 1974.

A person who knowingly makes a false statement for the purpose of obtaining the grant or issue to himself or any other person, of a resident's parking permit shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds.
